Meeting Summary (July 25th)

JD Solomon, Pee Dee River Basin Council Facilitator, called the July 25th meeting of the Pee Dee RBC to order at 9:00 AM. The fourteenth meeting of the Pee Dee RBC was held virtually via the Zoom virtual meeting platform (virtual-only). Including the Pee Dee RBC members and planning team, there were 39 people present at this RBC meeting online.

The meeting began with JD Solomon reviewing the agenda items for the meeting. The Pee Dee RBC approved the RBC meeting agenda and will approve the minutes and summary documents from the June 27th meeting at the August meeting. A public comment period was held with no comments. An agency public comment period was held with no comments received.

The first item on the agenda was an update from Andrea Hughes, USGS. The coastal plain groundwater modeling work is continuing to progress as the USGS team is transferring the coastal plain groundwater model from MODFLOW NWT to MODFLOW 6 and working to shorten model runs. Calibration run results will be available to present to the Pee Dee RBC at the August meeting.

Matt Lindburg, Brown & Caldwell, presented current drafts of the first three chapters of the Pee Dee river basin plan. The first three chapters included the introduction, description of the basin, and the water resources of the basin. Matt highlighted the draft contents of each of the chapters and updated the RBC on next steps.

JD Solomon and Buddy Richardson concluded the meeting at 9:41 AM. The next meeting of the Pee Dee RBC will be August 22nd, 2023 at the Clemson Pee Dee REC.
