
ePermitting Online Services

ePermitting is designed to work best using MS Edge or Google Chrome on a personal computer. Users may also find that ePermitting works on tablets, but we do not recommend accessing it on a phone.

Supported Programs: Agriculture, Asbestos, Coastal Zone Consistency, Critical Area Permitting, Dam Safety, Groundwater Withdrawal, Infectious Waste, Mining and Reclamation, Navigable Waters/Water Quality Certification, Oil and Gas Terminal Facilities, Private Wells, Septic Tanks, Stormwater, Surface Water Withdrawal, Wastewater



2. Once signed in, on the left side menu select **Start a New Form**;
