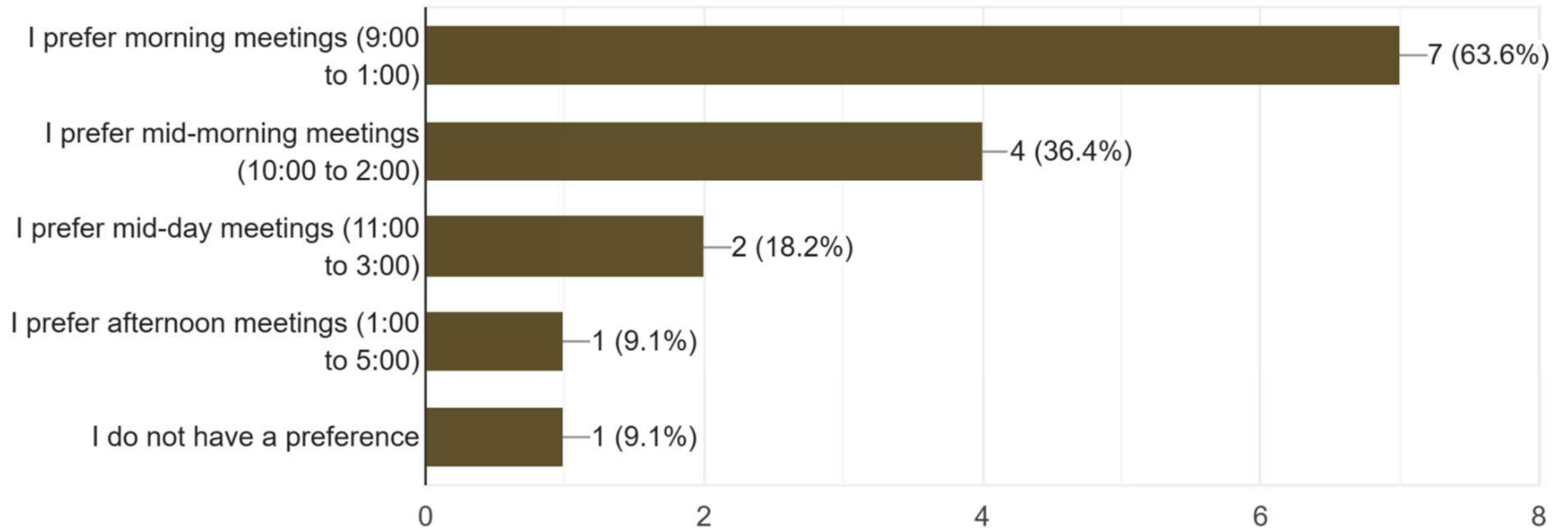

- **Discussion: RBC Meeting time, duration, date and location preferences**

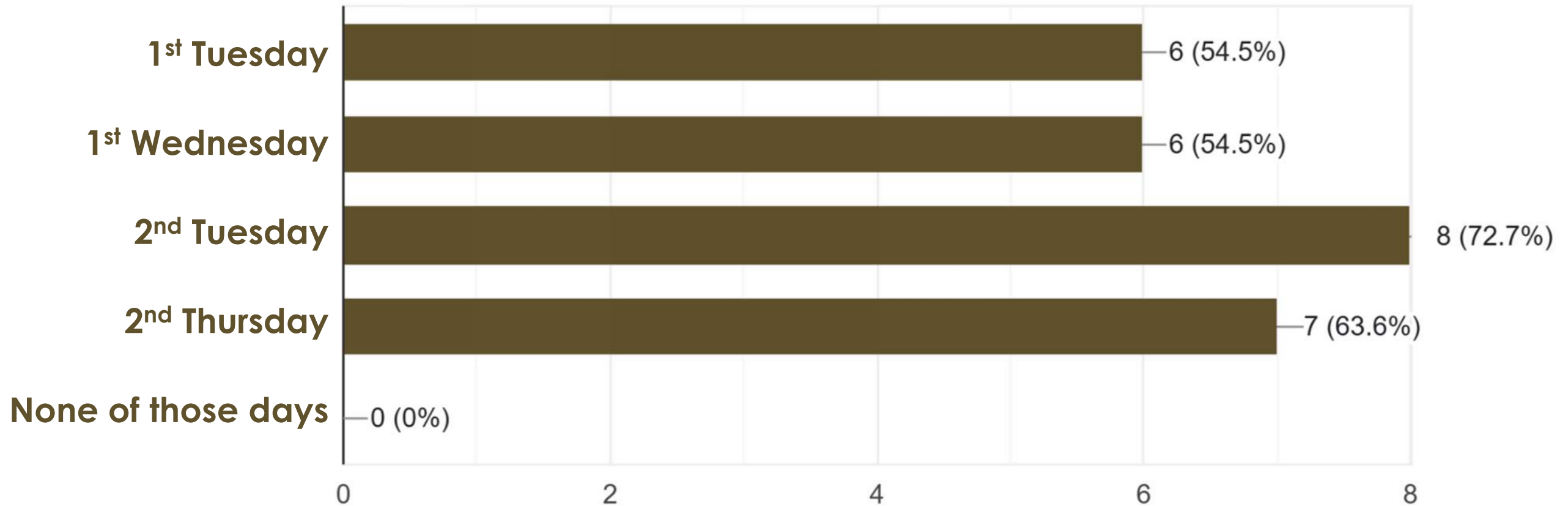
Santee RBC Survey
