Starting the package

Select Start a New Form in the left-hand menu. Select the appropriate option for the form type. Use the filter or scroll to locate the appropriate submission package. Packages have a button to the right: View Package. Click to start the submission.

Working in the submission package

You should see all forms associated with the submission package. If you are creating a new site, you need to start the first form first to get the new site created. You can then work on the forms in any order. All required forms need to be completed before the package can be submitted. Each form may or may not require a user to be Certified to submit the form. If they are required, it will be required to update the form's status from Draft to Staged. It is not required again to submit the submission package.

Getting back to the submission package

If you need to access the submission package after getting out of it, you can see it on your Dashboard or under Submissions. If a form has been started but not submitted, it, and the submission package, will be in Draft status. Once that form has been submitted, it will move to Staged status.
