- 1 Keep the program simple.**
The easier it is to understand, the more participation you should see.



- 2 Inspire friendly competition.**
Create contests and offer prizes. Measure by weight or volume and cleanliness to help decrease contamination.



- 3 Set attainable goals.**
Set reachable goals that can be met easily. As the program grows set bigger goals.

Top 5 Tips for Successful Recycling at Your Business

1 Secure support. Be sure to have support from top leadership within your organization. They will be critical to create a positive waste reduction workplace culture.



2 Use the “Twin the Bin” method. Anywhere there is a trash can, there should also be a clearly labeled recycling bin.



3 Measurement matters. Keep track of how much material is recycled by weight or volume. This will show areas for improvement and provide data for the S.C. Solid Waste Management Annual Report.



4 Design educational material for employees and visitors. These should focus on how to recycle correctly while at the facility.



5 Buy recycled-content products to close the loop. This ensures recycling success. Consider implementing a green purchasing policy.
