GRANT AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES

AND

Kind Keeper

This Agreement by and between the South Carolina Department of Environmental Services (SCDES) and Kind Keeper (Recipient) existing under the laws of South Carolina, is to provide for the distribution of funds \$300,000 (the Funds) appropriated in 2024 Act 226, Part IB, Section 118.20 (88)(f).

The parties agree as follows:

A. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:

The purpose of the agreement is to provide funding to the Recipient, in support of Kind Keeper Building Fund. This agreement furthers SCDES's statutory mission as authorized in South Carolina Code Section 118.20 (88)(f) and serves the public purpose of rescuing homeless animals.

B. SCOPE OF SERVICES:

The Recipient shall utilize the funds for the activities and services outlined and approved in supporting documents and the attached Exhibit 1 as completed with supporting documents, which will be incorporated into the Agreement upon acceptance under Paragraph D.

C. TERM:

This Agreement shall be effective upon signature, calendar year 2024 and shall terminate on June 30, 2025. Recipient's obligations under this Agreement shall survive termination.

D. PAYMENT:

- 1. Recipient shall submit a written request for payment not to exceed \$300,000 and shall include with the request the information on the attached Exhibit I, including the following as required by Proviso 118.20 and SCDES:
 - a. An accounting of how the Funds will be spent (Planned Expenditure Summary)

- b. Goals to be accomplished, and
- c. Proposed measures to evaluate success in implementing and meeting goals.
- 2. Upon acceptance by SCDES, the request for payment will be incorporated into and made part of this Agreement.
- 3. Recipient must register with SCEIS as a vendor and provide vendor information on the request for payment.
- 4. Payment is contingent on SCDES receipt of Funds.
- 5. Upon receipt and review and approval of the Planned Expenditure Summary, Funds Budget, and financial statements, SCDES will transmit the funds to Recipient by check delivered to:

E. <u>REPORTING REQUIREMENTS:</u>

1. By June 30th, 2025, Recipient shall submit to SCDES a report containing a detailed accounting of its use of the Funds, the services completed, and the outcome measures used to determine the success of the stated goals in sufficient detail for SCDES to determine Recipient's compliance with the Scope of Services set forth in Paragraph B above. See Exhibit II (Quarterly Expenditure Report) and expected completion date by which it anticipates all funds will be spent. Recipient shall also submit a final report with this information if the project is not completed or the Funds have not been spent by June 30, 2025, Recipient shall include in its report an explanation why the Funds have not been spent or the project is not complete and an expected completion date by which it anticipates all funds will have been spent. Recipient shall also submit a final report with this information within 90 days after project completion or exhaustion of Funds.

- 2. Recipient shall submit to SCDES by June 30, 2025, a detailed statement explaining the nature and function of its organization as well as a detailed statement explaining the use that was made of the funds using the attached template(s).
- 3. Recipient will allow the State Auditor to audit or cause to be audited to funds.

F. PREVENTING AND REPORTING FRAUD, WASTE AND ABUSE:

- SCDES has procedures and policies concerning the prevention and reporting of fraud, waste and abuse (FWA) in agency-funded programs, including but not limited to those funded by federal grants. No agency employee, agent, or Recipient shall direct, participate in, approve, or tolerate any violation of federal or State laws regarding FWA in government programs.
- b. Federal law prohibits any person or company from knowingly submitting false or fraudulent claims or statements to a federally funded program, including false claims for payment or conspiracy to get such a claim approved or paid. The False Claims Act, 31 U.S.C. §3729-3733, and other "whistleblower" statutes include remedies for employees who are retaliated against in their employment for reporting violations of the Act or for reporting fraud, waste, abuse, or violations of law in connection with federal grant agreements or grants, or danger to public health or safety. Under State law, persons may be criminally prosecuted for false claims made for insurance fraud, or for using a computer in a fraud scheme or to obtain money or services by false representations.
- c. If Recipient or Recipient's agents or employees have reason to suspect FWA in SCDES programs, this information should be reported in confidence to SCDES. A report may be made by writing to the Office of Internal Audits, SCDES, 2600 Bull Street, Columbia, SC 29201; or by calling the SCDES Fraud, Waste and Abuse Hotline at 803-898-7533 accessing the OIA Intranet Website, or sending an email to fraud.hotline@des.sc.gov. Recipient is required to inform Recipient's employees of the existence of SCDES's policy prohibiting FWA and the procedures for reporting FWA to the agency. Recipient must also inform recipient's employees, in writing, of their rights and remedies under 41 U.S.C. §4712 concerning reporting FWA or violations of law in connection with federal contracts or grants, or danger to public health or safety, in the predominant native language of the workforce.

G. <u>USE OF FUNDS</u>; <u>AUDITS</u>:

Recipient will not use, expend, or allow use or expenditure of the Funds for any purpose not authorized in and consistent with this Agreement. Unexpended funds distributed pursuant to this Agreement may be carried forward to succeeding fiscal years and expended for the same purposes. Recipient shall continue the reporting and monitoring required under this Agreement until all Funds are spent.

H. <u>RETURN OF FUNDS</u>: The State of South Carolina reserves the right to all remedies available to it under law for the enforcement of this Agreement including but not limited to the right to demand repayment of any Funds that remain unused at completion of the project or that were used for purposes not authorized in this Agreement.

I. <u>NON-DISCRIMINATION:</u>

No person shall be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination in relation to activities carried out under this Contract on the grounds of race, religion, color, sex, age, national origin, disability, veteran status, pregnancy, gender identity, sexual orientation, or any other basis prohibited by law. This includes the provision of language assistance services to individuals of limited English proficiency eligible for services provided by SCDES.

Recipients that administer or provide SCDES programs, activities, and services are required to adopt policies and procedures that ensure individuals with disabilities are provided with an equal opportunity to participate and equally effective communication when accessing any SCDES funded programs, activities, and services.

- J. <u>COMPLIANCE REPORTS:</u> Recipient must provide quarterly compliance reports within fifteen days after the end of each quarter outlining the status of the project, compliance with the scope of services, and documentation of expenditures to the proper program area of SCDES. Recipient is subject to site visits from SCDES to monitor compliance.
- K. <u>RECORDKEEPING</u>: Recipient shall create and maintain adequate records to document all matters covered by this Agreement. Recipient shall retain all such records for three (3) years or other longer period required by law after termination, cancellation, or expiration of the Agreement or after final expenditure of Funds, whichever is later, and make records available for inspection, copying, and audit by SCDES or other authorized agent of the State. If any litigation, claim, or audit has begun but is not completed or if audit findings have not been resolved at the end of the retention period, the records shall be retained until all litigation, claims, or audit findings involving the Funds have been resolved.
- L. <u>REVISIONS OF LAW:</u> The provisions of the Agreement are subject to revision of state or federal statutes and regulations and requirements governing.
- M. <u>PUBLIC INFORMATION</u>: All information relating to distribution and use of the Funds, including all reports and documentation submitted to SCDES under this Agreement, is subject to public disclosure under the South Carolina Freedom of Information Act and may be published on SCDES's internet web site.
- N. <u>ATTACHMENTS</u>: Attachments to this Agreement are incorporated into and made part of this Agreement.

The parties to this Grant Agreement hereby agree to any and all provisions of the Grant Agreement as stated above.

Dear Mr. Bailey,

Kind Keeper Animal Rescue (Kind Keeper, Inc) became operational as a small, community-based No-Kill, non-profit in 2016. We are usually "over" capacity with animals living in overflow crates and office areas. Since 2016 Kind Keeper has rescued almost 6,000 dogs and cats! We doubled animal intakes and adoptions in 2020 coinciding with the pandemic. Since 2020 our numbers continue at over 1000 intakes annually which is amazing given that our space has not increased since 2016.

We serve not only the Grand Strand area but also surrounding counties (Horry, Dillon, Marlboro, Marion, Florence, Georgetown). We accept transfers from county shelters, owner surrenders, and found strays. What makes Kind Keeper unique is that 70-80% of our intakes are "at risk" animals that includes pregnant, newborn, senior, sick, and injured animals.

Kind Keeper Animal Rescue is not affiliated with any city, county, or state entities. We rely totally on donations and grants to fund operations and capital improvements. We are sincerely grateful for the kind and generous support of our community, including your daughter Anne Marie, that enables us to continue our mission of rescuing homeless animals.

Kind Keeper serves our community in other ways:

- We regularly donate dog and cat food to local food banks and feral cat colony caregivers.
- Our volunteers take puppies and kittens to visit 10 local nursing home residents monthly.
 This win-win activity provides socialization for the animals and enriches the day for the residents.
- Our volunteers also take puppies and kittens to visit local schools and group homes. They provide information on the humane care of pets.

 Our staff and volunteers provide public education related to the importance of spay/neuter surgery, regular veterinary care, heart worm prevention, and other animal related topics.
 Educational events are in-person or via radio, TV, web, and social media platforms.

We currently lease space in a building that used to be a military barracks in the 1950's. The building is old, cramped, and incredibly challenging in terms of animal shelter operational needs. We must use mops and buckets to clean the kennels because there are no drains in the floors. The dogs must walk through the shelter to gain access to outside yards for exercise. Staff must carry water from the kitchen area throughout the shelter to provide fresh water for yards and animal kennels. Over the past 2 years the building has deteriorated significantly, making it necessary for Kind Keeper to pay for repairs or replacement of floors, cabinets, countertops, sinks and other parts of the structure used daily by animals and staff. We really worry about how much longer the building will hold up for the day-to-day management and care of our animals.

A generous donation enabled us to pay cash for over 10 acres of land in 2021. We have been fundraising to build a new shelter for the past two years and currently have \$176K in our capital improvement fund. We have the project planned and are at the stage where we are ready to pull permits to begin construction, pending funds to proceed. It will cost between \$1,500,000 and \$2,000,000 for Phase 1 of the project: construction of the shelter portion of the building. Phase 2 would need additional funds to add a low-cost veterinary clinic that would provide spay/neuter surgery, exams, and low-cost vaccines to better serve our community.

Our ability to raise funds is impacted greatly by the fact that Grand Strand Humane Society and the Humane Society of North Myrtle Beach are both trying to raise \$6 million to build new shelters as well. Grand Strand Humane Society receives municipal funding from the city of Myrtle Beach. The Humane Society of North Myrtle Beach receives municipal funding from the city of North Myrtle Beach. Kind Keeper Animal Rescue does not receive any municipal funding and relies totally on donations and grants.

We deeply appreciate your assistance in helping Kind Keeper apply for a state grant to support the construction of a new shelter that will triple our capacity. To date we have spent almost \$350,000 paying for land, architectural drawings, and other preliminary building project planning.

Our 2023 total income was \$544,686. Our 2023 total expenses were \$482,006.

Thank you for taking the time to read our letter. We are happy to provide any additional information you may need for grant consideration. We'd love to have you visit and see first-hand what we do to serve the homeless animals in our community.

Summary of intended use of funds:

For new shelter to furnish living spaces and exercise areas to house for projected 2000 animals per year.

1. Guillotine doors, Kuranda beds, and run fencing for 29 dog kennels

- 2. Habitats, kitty condos and catios for large cat room and several cat kennel areas
- 3. Kennels, beds, and furnishings for puppy areas
- 4. Kennels, beds, and furnishings for senior dog areas
- 5. Kennels, sinks, cabinets for isolation room
- 6. Fencing and turf for 8 outdoor group play areas

Justification of request/public benefits:

Based on local media reports and shared information online, all rescues and shelters in the Grand Strand area have been operating at full or over capacity for the past 2 years. Kind Keeper's new building will triple our capacity to care for homeless and at-risk dogs and cats. Unlike Grand Strand Humane Society and the Humane Society of North Myrtle Beach, Kind Keeper does not receive regular funding from a municipal contract. We rely totally on donations and grants. We receive phone calls and online surrender applications daily and we are unable to help most because we stay full and over capacity with animals living in overflow crates and office space.

There are always more animals in need than available resources to take them in and provide for their care. Kind Keeper No-Kill Animal Rescue has increasingly helped the community over the past 8 years since opening its doors in leased space. Although the amount of space has not increased, the number of animals that we have cared for and placed in homes has grown tremendously! Public benefits include reducing the number of homeless pets by increasing our capacity, helping more people in the community

seeking to rehome their pets, and providing a cleaner, safer environment for the animals in our custody.





Kind Keeper Animal Rescue (KKAR, also known as Kind Keeper, Inc.) was founded in 2014 as a small, non-profit 501c3 organization by Belinda Mairowicz. Kind Keeper's mission is to actively rescue dogs and cats that are homeless, often suffering from medical problems, or at risk for euthanasia due to shelter over population. This includes a high population of newborns, pregnant animals, as well as senior animals. We provide veterinary care, proper nutrition, training, exercise, and love to prepare animals for adoption in the community. We accept owner surrenders, found strays, and animals from several surrounding county shelters that are overcrowded and have animals facing euthanasia.

Note: We are planning to build a new shelter at 2587 Watertower Road in Longs, SC. We paid cash for the land and are raising funds to be able to start construction. Attached is documentation that shows architectural plans for the new animal shelter and the new building project budget.
