DATABASE BACKGROUND

WHAT IS INCLUDED?

- Collaborative effort of ~20 land trusts throughout the state
 - Reflects properties protected by 67 different organizations, many are NGOs – easements and fee-owned
 - Represented organizations reflect a diversity of sizes: range from over 100,000 acres protected to <1,000 acres protected
 - Organizations collectively protect 950,000 acres throughout the state

DATABASE BACKGROUND

WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED?

- Does not include public data – for public data, use PAD-US
- Does not include HOA properties



PRIVACY ISSUES

- Privacy of information contained in database is of utmost concern
- Potential users of data are vetted for intended use before sharing
- Primary use is by non-profits and government organizations involved in conservation and planning

MOU AND DATA CONFIDENTIALITY

- MOU governing use of data
- Data share confidentiality agreement required for access
- Contact GIS Manager to request data and provide information on intended use
