Notice of Removal Activities, Public Meeting, & Administrative Record

Removal Activities

Vishay GSI, Inc. (VGSI), with the oversight of the South Carolina Department of Health & Environmental Control ("DHEC" or the "Department"), has been investigating environmental contamination at the former Nytronics Components Group, Inc. and the former MSD, Inc. facility located at 700 Orange Street, in Darlington, SC (the "Site") (Figure 1). The Department recently completed an evaluation of VGSI's proposal to remove contaminated material from the storm water sewer system as well as sediment in the western drainage ditch.

VGSI's proposal also includes the demolition of the building structures in order to safely access contaminated material beneath the structures. VGSI expects to begin the removal in the Spring of 2008. The remaining contaminated areas are currently being evaluated by VGSI and DHEC and will be addressed in the future as part of a site-wide cleanup effort.
