OPEN BURNING AFFECTS US ALL

What **CAN** be burned?

- Leaves
- Limbs
- Pine Straw / Pine Cones
- Lawn and Hedge Trimmings



If burning, remember to always:

- Actively watch the fire;
- Have water or other fire extinguishing measures readily available;
- Comply with county and local ordinances; and
- Notify S.C. Forestry Commission of any outdoor burning.



What **CANNOT** be burned?

- Cardboard / Paper
- Construction or Demolition Debris
- Electrical Wires
- Household Chemicals
- Household Garbage
- Metal, Aluminum or Tin Cans
- Oils
- Paint
- Plastics
- Tires / Rubber Products
- Treated or Painted Wood
